COVID-19 UPDATES

**LifeBridge Health is part of a public-private partnership with Baltimore City. As part of this partnership we offer the following updates to the West Baltimore community:**

- Grace Medical Center COVID 19 Testing tent (drive-up or walk-up) is open Monday-Friday 10am-12pm at no cost to the public. Individuals must have a prescription from their physician for testing. **However, individuals without a physician who are experiencing symptoms may call 211 to obtain a same day prescription to be tested.**
- Grace Medical Center has increased bed capacity to prepare for the surge of patients.
- There are no visitors allowed to the hospital including the Emergency Department. However, the following exceptions will be permitted:
  - One parent visitor per pediatric patient
  - One significant other for labor and delivery patients
  - One visitor for end-of-life care patients
  - One visitor for heart attack and stroke patients
  - One visitor if a patient is incapacitated

**\*\*\*PLEASE BE ADVISED ALL VISITORS MUST WEAR MASKS (PROVIDED BY THE HOSPITAL) WHEN IN THE HOSPITAL AND HAVE THEIR TEMPERATURE TAKEN AT THE DOOR\*\*\***

- While there are no visitors allowed, Walgreens is still open. Your temperature will be checked at the door before you can go into the Walgreens area and there are directions to keep the line appropriate for social distancing guidelines. Your patience and assistance with these measures are greatly appreciated.
